

Cruise sector boosts Dubai tourism

With the cruise sector continuing to play a larger role in Dubai's tourism industry, the emirate recently welcomed the second largest cruise ship ever to come to the UAE. Royal Caribbean's 137,276 tonne, 3840 guests-capacity mega cruise liner Voyager of the Seas arrived in Dubai's Port Rashid on Tuesday after completing a 15-day journey from Barcelona.

The arrival of the cruise ship, which stopped in Dubai on its way to Singapore for the next leg of its journey, confirmed the capacity and capability of Dubai's tourism industry, said the head of Dubai's Department of Tourism and Commerce Marketing, Hamad bin Mejren.
